On the 108th Anniversary of the Great October Socialist Revolution At the Event Organized by the Communist Party of Greece

Dear Comrades,

On behalf of the Communist Party of Pakistan, I send our warm revolutionary greetings to the Communist Party of Greece, to its leadership, its courageous members, and to the working class of Greece, which stands proudly at the front line of the class struggle in Europe.

We deeply appreciate the initiative of the Communist Party of Greece in organizing this event to celebrate the one hundred and eighth anniversary of the Great October Socialist Revolution. Bourgeois democracy is decaying creating ways for authoritarianism, while fascist tendencies thrive on nationalism and despair. These are not signs of system's strength but of systemic decay. Our duty as communists is to prepare the working class politically and ideologically, to expose the lies of bourgeois and pseudo-left parties, and to unite workers and the oppressed under a clear program for socialist revolution.

Dear comrades, the October Revolution showed that a proletarian victory in one country is only the beginning of a global revolutionary process. The Bolsheviks knew their survival depended on spreading revolution abroad. Today, proletarian internationalism is not a

slogan but an essential necessity for advancing our cause.

The Communist Party of Pakistan is committed to strengthening ties with the international communist movement, especially with fraternal parties like the KKE that uphold Marxism-Leninism and oppose all imperialist blocs. We stand in solidarity with the working class of Greece and all revolutionary forces worldwide fighting imperialism and capitalist exploitation.
